- *Tom Francis, Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) Water Resources Manager, submitted written comment to the Commission, read a portion of the comment relating to the Water Supply Agreement with the City and County of San Francisco, stated BAWSCA met with SFPUC staff and reviewed material in advance of the 10-Year Capital Plan and two-year Capital Budget presentation, and stated the two groups planned to engage in discussion on that day.*
- *Stephen Rainaldi, City of Millbrae Vice Mayor, provided comment urging the Commission to curtail the one-half billion dollar capital improvement plan for the Millbrae parcel on El Camino Real.*
- *Ann Schneider, former City of Millbrae Mayor and current Millbrae representative to BAWSCA, provided comment describing Millbrae as an overburdened community and as regional infrastructure that SFPUC, San Francisco International Airport (SFO), Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART), Caltrain, California High-Speed Rail, and Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) all cause significant economic harm by taking City of Millbrae land.*
