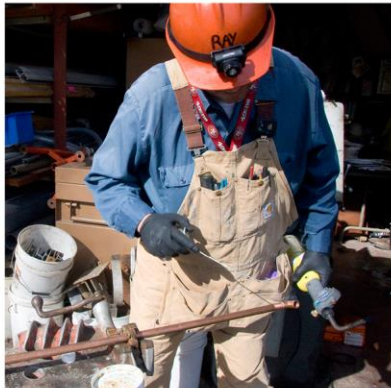

The following information about upcoming contracting opportunities – both for construction and professional services from the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) – is being distributed by the Contractors Assistance Center (Center) to help small, local business of the opportunities. However, the information provided herein is subject to change without notice and being listed here is not a guarantee that projects will be advertised for bid without notice and being listed here is not a guarantee that will be advertised for bid or awarded by the SFPUC. The advertisement dates of the projects “in development” are only projections and projects many may not advertise during the timeframe specified or in the order listed, if at all. Moreover, this is not a complete list of contracting opportunities with the SFPUC. Please refer to the bid advertisement and contract documents for the final details.

Additionally, public works contracts with the SFPUC are subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement of prevailing wage requirements by the California Department of Industrial Relations and the San Francisco Office of Labor Standards Enforcement. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid for a public works project awarded a public works project unless registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations. Registration is annual and runs July 1 to June 30. Registration renewal opens May 1. Registration and renewals should be completed online at <https://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/Contractors.html>.
