San Andreas Pipeline No. 3 **Drainage & Erosion Repair in Junipero Serra Park**

When: Construction is anticipated to begin September 22, 2025, with completion anticipated by June 2026. Weather and construction issues could impact the schedule. General workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Some night and weekend work may be required.

Where: The work will be performed within Junipero Serra Park in San Mateo County adjacent to San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's (SFPUC) water mains – San Andreas Pipeline #2 and #3. Please see the project map below.

Why: SFPUC's water mains provide drinking water to the City of San Francisco. This project will protect San Francisco's water mains by repairing erosion and diverting stormwater away from those water lines. This is a joint project between SFPUC, City of San Bruno and San Mateo County Parks.

What to expect during construction: Most of the construction work will be performed in undeveloped areas of Junipero Serra Park, Reservations at the Oak Cove Picnic Area will be prohibited for approximately 8 weeks, though there will be full access to other park facilities.
