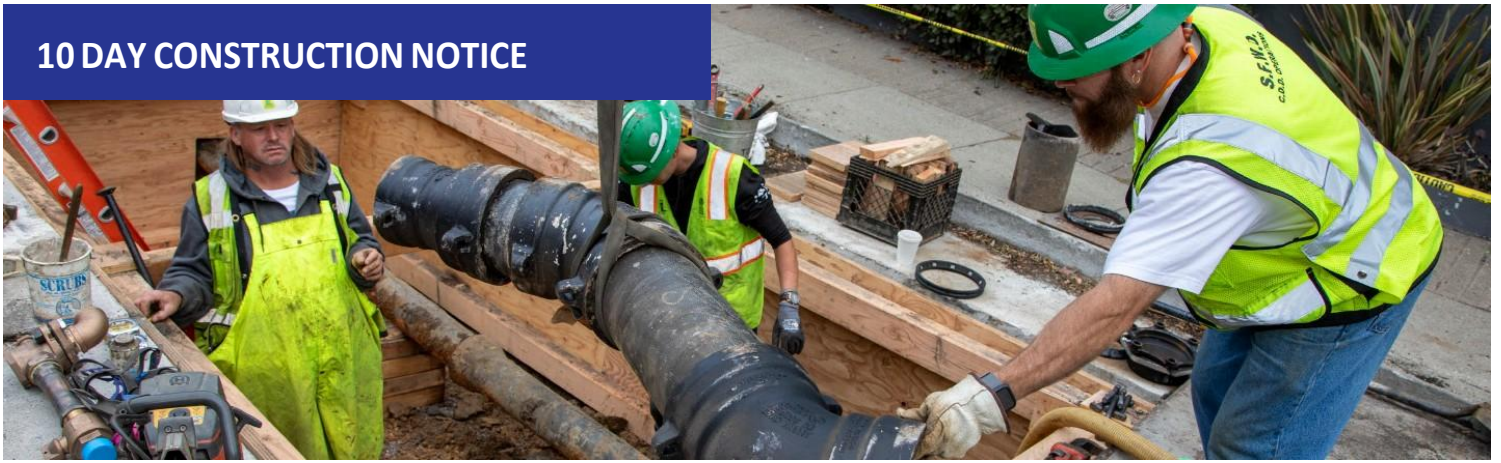


10 DAY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



WATER & SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Grand View Avenue from Clipper Street to Romain Street and various area streets

When: Construction is anticipated to begin on September 22, with completion anticipated by Spring 2026. Weather and construction issues could impact the schedule. General workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Some night and weekend work may be required.

Where: Water work will occur on Grand View Avenue between Clipper Street and Romain Street, as well as 25th Street, 24th Street, 23rd Street, 22nd Street, Alvarado Street, Elizabeth Street, Fountain Street, Hoffman Avenue and Romain Street. Sewer work will occur only on 22nd Street from Hoffman Avenue to Worth Street; on Hoffman Avenue from Elizabeth Street to Alvarado Street; and on 25th Street from Fountain Street to Hoffman Avenue. Please see the project map on the obverse side.

Why: To ensure reliable water service in your neighborhood, we are replacing pipes that are approaching the end of their useful life and installing new water mains.

What to expect during construction: Water main installation is done in phases, so work will not be happening on your block for the entire project duration. There may also be periods of inactivity during the work dates. Local access for residents will be provided at all times during work hours, though there may be some slight delay to enter or exit your property/driveway to allow for crews to create a safe path of travel.



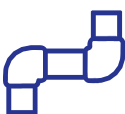
Contractor will place “no parking signs” on street where construction will take place 72 hours in advance per San Francisco Municipal code. Parking is prohibited in the work zone only during construction hours.



Contractor will excavate a trench where new water main pipe is to be installed. There will be noise, vibration, dust, parking and traffic impacts in the work zone and some disruption to normal neighborhood activity.



Contractor will install pipe and refill the trench with special materials to protect the pipe. The contractor will temporarily pave the excavated area and return at a later date for the final paving. Temporary paving could be in place for weeks or even months on larger projects.



SF Water Department will connect new water main pipe to properties. This will involve a temporary interruption of water service. Crews will provide advance notice a minimum of 24 hours.



Once the entire project has been completed, final paving is performed. All equipment and materials are removed from street.
