

Construction Notice: Wawona and Vicente Street Stormwater and Water Main Replacement

Description: As part of the Wawona and Vicente Street Stormwater and Water Main Replacement project, crews will return to the intersection of 15th and Wawona and adjacent streets to continue construction activities to upgrade and install a new manhole, sewer pipes, storm drains, and catch basins.


When: Crews will begin site mobilization and construction activities the week of May 16th. Activities are anticipated to be completed in October 2022 at the beginning of the rainy season. Weather and/or construction issues may impact the schedule. Workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some night work and weekend work may be required, in which case advanced notice will be given.

Where: Construction activities will take place at the intersection of 15th Avenue and Wawona Street, as well as portions of the street along Wawona Street and 15th Avenue. Construction staging will occur along some nearby side streets in the immediate vicinity.

What to expect:

- Parking will be impacted on 15th Ave between Vicente Street and West Portal Avenue, and also on Wawona Street between Vicente Street and 16th Avenue.
- While the contractor is required to abide by the City's noise ordinances, neighbors should expect some noise and limited dust during this work. The project team will work to minimize disruption to normal neighborhood activity; however, there will be occasional inconveniences due to heavy equipment movement and other construction activities.
- Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their properties (including entries, driveways, garages), although there may be temporary delays
- No interruption in sewer service is expected during construction, interruption to water services may occur in which advance notice will be given

Sewer improvements are funded through the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) – a 20-year, multibillion dollar citywide investment required to upgrade our aging sewer infrastructure to ensure a reliable and seismically safe sewer system now and for generations to come.
