

Making Upgrades

Water Utility Service Notice

Description: As part of the Wawona and Vicente Street Stormwater and Water Main Replacement project, crews continue to progress water utility upgrades and water main replacement work along Vicente Street, progressing from 31st Avenue eastward towards 28th Avenue.

As a result of these activities, residents should expect intermittent water service down time (for a few hours at a time) for service change overs in the coming weeks between 34th Avenue and 31st Avenue.


When: Newly constructed water service connections will begin the week of May 9. Weather and/or construction issues may impact the schedule. Workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some night work and weekend work may be required, in which case advanced notice will be given.

Where: Impacted locations include residential and businesses along Vicente Street and the adjacent site streets between 34th Avenue and 31st Avenue.

What to expect:

- While the contractor is required to abide by the City's noise and vibration ordinances, neighbors should expect some noise and limited dust during this work. The project team will work to minimize disruption to normal neighborhood activity; however, there will be occasional inconveniences due to heavy equipment movement and other construction activities
- Through traffic during the work activities will remain open
- Some parking will be impacted for staging of equipment along the cross streets adjacent to Vicente Street (see map opposite side), advanced notice will be given
- Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their properties (including entries, driveways, garages), although there may be temporary delays

Sewer improvements are funded through the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) – a 20-year, multibillion dollar citywide investment required to upgrade our aging sewer infrastructure to ensure a reliable and seismically safe sewer system now and for generations to come.
